

The Book of Leviticus is the third book of the Torah and of the Old Testament. Most of its chapters (1-7, 11-27) consist of God's speeches to Moses, which God

commands Moses to repeat to the Israelites. This takes place within the story of the Israelites' Exodus after they escaped Egypt and reached Mt. Sinai (Exodus 19:1). In Leviticus, God tells the Israelites and their priests how to make offerings in the Tabernacle and how to conduct themselves while camped around the holy tent sanctuary.

The instructions of Leviticus emphasize ritual, legal and moral practices rather than beliefs. Nevertheless, they reflect the world view of the creation story in Genesis 1 that God wishes to live with humans. The book teaches that faithful performance of the sanctuary rituals can make that possible, so long as the people avoid sin and impurity whenever possible. The rituals, especially the sin and guilt offerings, provide the means to gain forgiveness for sins (Leviticus 4–5) and purification from impurities (Leviticus 11–16) so that God can continue to live in the Tabernacle in the midst of the people.

Theme: Leviticus also illustrates that God was concerned that His people do what is right, and do it in the right way. Here are its five interlocking themes:

- -- Holiness: Holy and holiness occur 95 times in Leviticus, more than any other book in the Bible. Leviticus reveals that a God who is set apart from all other "gods" must have a similar people.
- -- Worship: Approaching a holy God is not a casual undertaking. Dealing with the sin that separates man from God requires sacrifice, which reflects death as the consequence of sin. The payment for sin, through the offering of sacrifices "without blemish" or "defect". The sacrificial system was a lesson concerning the importance and cost of maintaining fellowship with the holy God.
- -- Law: Leviticus is filled with regulations and ordinances, all of which reveal our inability as humans to be perfect on our own. The Levitical laws would set the stage for laws that would one day be written on the hearts of God's people rather that on stone, replacing external obligation with internal motivation.
- -- Presence: God's willingness to dwell in the midst of as sinful people -- camped in Israel in the Holy of Holies in the tabernacle -- would be a sign of His forgiveness and grace toward those He redeemed to Himself.
- -- Atonement: Sins can be atoned for in the manner of God's choosing (chap. 16-17). In our English Bibles the word atonement is found 51 times in Leviticus, with the basic meaning "to cover", or "to make a covering". Old Testament atonement did not remove sins, but it covered sins until, ultimately, a final sacrifice would be made when the perfect Lamb of God offered Himself once and for all - Heb. 9:1-15, 24-28; 10:1-14.

The travel arrangements have not been completed ... More information to come.




